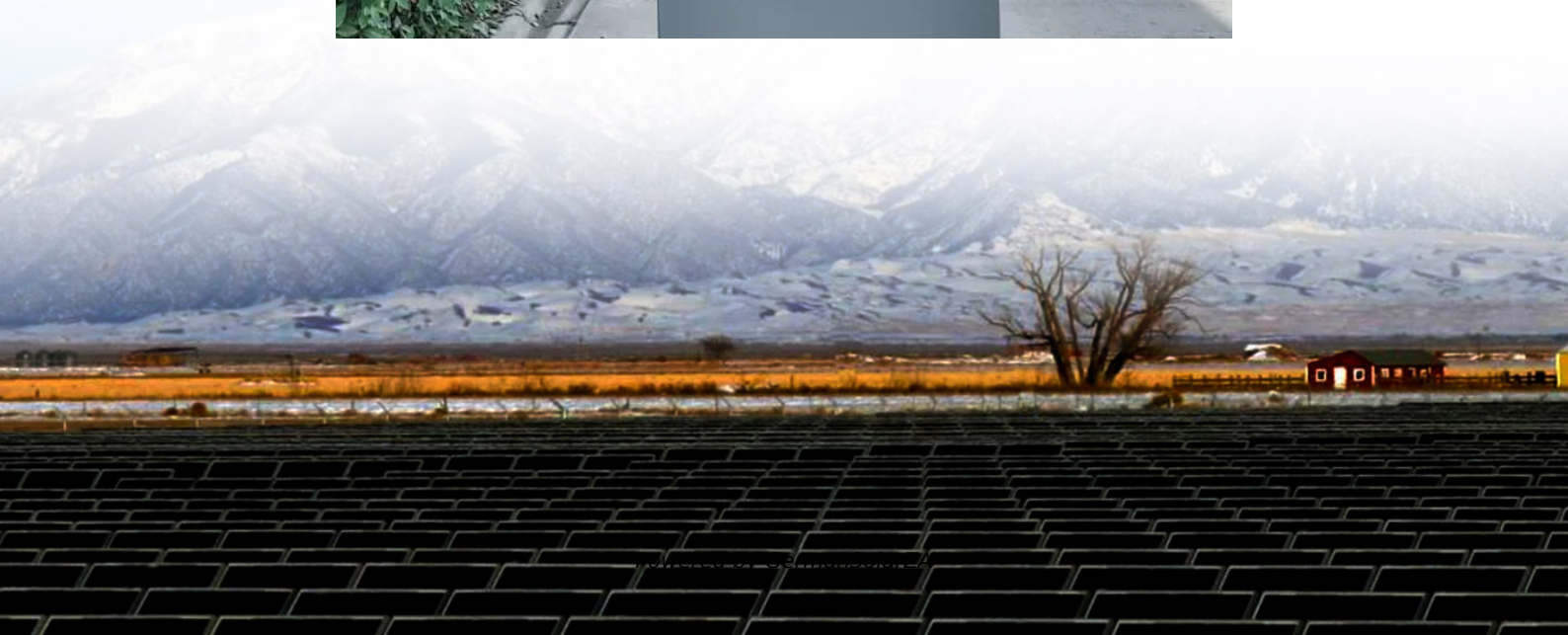

Superlatives like "highest" don't have to be preceded by the definite article "the," as I demonstrated in the alternative to "at the highest": "at its highest." However, since only one ...

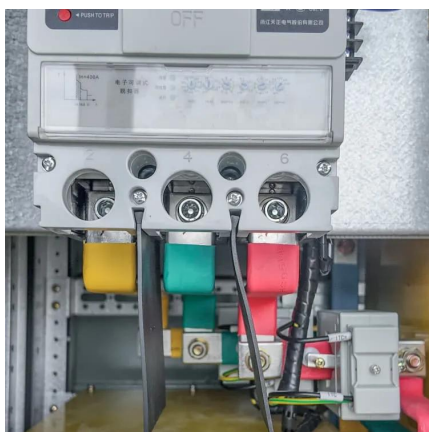

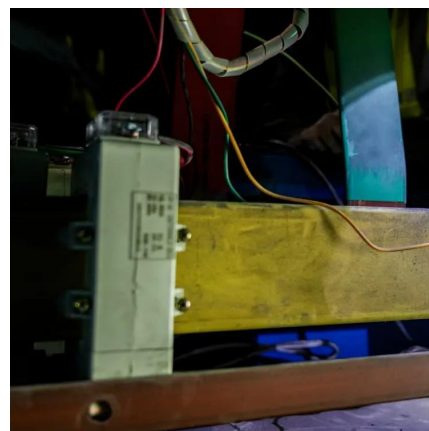
